

NAME

imagemw - output metafile to Apple Imagewriter

SYNOPSIS

imagemw [**-c** | **-r**] file ..

DESCRIPTION

Imagemw reads each metafile *file* in sequence and converts it to output suitable for the Apple Imagewriter dot-matrix printer. If the option *c* is specified, the input files are only conditioned for output, ie. expanded and sorted (see *pexpand* and *psort*). This is useful if many copies of the same output is desired. If the option *r* is instead specified, the input is assumed already to be conditioned. If no input files are specified, the standard input is read.

-c Condition the input only.

-r Input is already conditioned, output only.

EXAMPLE

To print the plot file example.plt:

```
bgraph example.plt | output imagew
```
